"Green Border" tells a story of the events taking place at the turn of the year 2021/2022, at the Polish-Belarusian border. In those days, the Polish government sealed the border area in order to hide from the world the scale of the inhumane treatment and violence inflicted on the people migrating to Europe.

The closed zone in the Podlasie region was abolished more than a year ago, but the humanitarian crisis is still ongoing. The tragedy of the most vulnerable groups pictured in the "Green Border" is still taking place daily. And, according to the testimonies of the people on the move, the violence committed by the Belarusian and the Polish border guards has become even more brutal in the recent months.

Grupa Granica has delivered humanitarian aid to more than three thousand people since the beginning of 2023, nearly as many as in all of 2022. Since the very beginning of the crisis, we have managed to reach 10 thousand people and supply them with food, water, clothing, and medical assistance.

Yet another winter is ahead of us.

Due to the low temperatures, often dropping below zero, winter is the most dangerous season for the people on the move who are often stuck for weeks in a dense forest, with no access to shelter.

Our friends – Danuta Kuroń, a legend of the Polish democratic opposition during the communist regime, and Mikołaj Grymberg, a brilliant writer and the author of the book "Jesus died in Poland" about the crisis at the border – created a fundraiser so that Grupa Granica can continue its work.
